In one of Cervat Yeril's interviews, he said that 64-bit processors on a 64-bit OS will have a 10-15% increase in performance per thread, so a dual core, expect a 20-30% increase in performance, adding the 20-25% increase for having dual core, so that's about a 55% increase, which is pretty darn good.
